

# Save the Home of Napoleon I on St Helena Appeal

## Project Summary and Appeal Results as of 1 February, 2012



### The project

- Restoration and reconstruction of the "Generals' Wing"
- Restoration of Longwood apartment interiors
- Restoration of apartment furniture from Longwood

### International fundraising campaign

As of 1 February 2012, the campaign has raised: 1,063,600 euros, of which:

- 100,000 euros from the Fondation du Patrimoine
- 50,000 euros from the Souvenir Napoléonien
- 50,000 euros from the Fondation Napoléon
- 720,135 euros from private donors
- 135,465 euros from companies and associations
- 8,000 euros from interest on investments.

### Expenditures, financial commitments, and budget forecasts

- 700,000 euros assigned to the "Generals' Wing" (total budget of 1.4 million euros, that is: 50% funded by campaign, 50% funded by French Ministry of Foreign and European Affairs)
- 75,000 euros for work on Longwood apartment interiors
- 226,056 euros for Longwood furniture (including transportation, restoration work, and exhibition in Paris)
- 20,000 euros held in reserve for unforeseen costs or possible over-budget expenses
- 42,544 euros (4%) for general expenses (printing of fundraising documents, franking, sundries).
